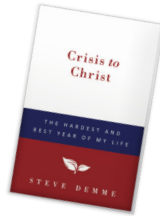

I have the potential to build up my family. I also have the ability to tear down my family. I am learning to respond thoughtfully instead of reacting emotionally.



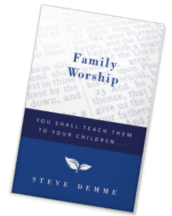
HYMNS FOR FAMILY WORSHIP
